I think the 3 prints which I have the pleasure to send will show that the picture ^{is} of Hood, and your picture may be by Northcote and not by Reynolds, but of this I will try and obtain more accurate information if you will please

to let me know your im-
-pression after comparing this
print from Northcote with the
picture. Whether by Reynolds,
or his pupil Northcote, in
all probability the artist did
more than one portrait of so
distinguished an Admiral.

I find Hood's name men-
-tioned in Reynolds' life as
having had his house injured
by the mob after Admiral
Keppel's trial, but no men-
-tion of a portrait having
been painted of him by Reynolds,

at least I have not ~~found~~
it at present.

Pray allow me this op-
~~portunity~~ of thanking you
for your great kindness to
me at Portsmouth; I
enjoyed my visit to the
"Glatton" exceedingly; the
Captain did all he could
to make his complicated
and wonderful ship intel-
ligible and interesting to
us; - and I shall al-
ways remember my

visit as one of the
bright days of life. -
