Heads of Proposed Declaration of  
Trust of the Share in the late Sir Alfred  
Phillips Ryder's Marriage Settlement funds  
bequeathed to the late Gerard Finch Dawson Esq.

The Share of the late Sir A. P. Ryder's Marriage  
Settlement funds bequeathed to the late Mr  
Gerard Finch Dawson (subject to Mrs Augusta  
Ryder's life interest therein) viz: two thirds of one  
equal moiety thereof is assigned to

William Dudley Ryder Esq<sup>r</sup> and George  
Lisle Ryder Esq<sup>r</sup> as Trustees

Upon trust when the same falls into possession  
to convert the fund into money and to invest  
the proceeds in their names and to hold the  
investments

Upon trust to pay the income to Mrs  
Dora Harriet Dawson for life and after her  
death to hold the funds

In trust for such of the children of the  
late Mr Gerard Finch Dawson as being  
sons attaining 21 or being daughters attaining  
that age or marry and if more than one  
in equal shares

but if there shall be no child of Mr  
Gerard Finch Dawson who attains a vested  
interest in the funds then they are to  
be held

In trust for Mrs Newnham her executors  
administrators and assigns absolutely.

It is proposed to add  
Mr Newnham as a  
Trustee if he approves.

It is presumed  
Mrs Dawson's  
children are all  
under age. -

Though this provision  
is inserted as to  
duties & expenses  
it is understood Mr.  
Dawson will pay  
those now accruing.

A direction is given to the Trustees when the funds fall into possession to raise and pay all legacy or succession duty payable in respect of them and the costs of the Settlement and the proper proportion of the probate duty payable under Sir A. P. Ryder's Will in respect of the funds.

The power of Investment authorises the following securities viz: The Public Stocks or funds or Government Securities of the United Kingdom or India or any Colony or Dependency of the United Kingdom - Freehold, copyhold, leasehold or chattel real securities in England or Wales - The Stocks, funds, shares, debentures, debenture stock mortgages or securities of any Corporation Company or Public Body, Municipal local, commercial, or otherwise in the United Kingdom or India or any Colony or Dependency of the United Kingdom

There are also the usual formal indemnity and other trust clauses in the Deed.
