

SPENCER'S RELATIONS

Father

Henry Ryder (3rd son of 1st Baron Harrowby of Sandon Hall, Staffs) born 1777. Rector of Lutterworth, Leicestershire, 1802-15; Dean of Wells, 1812-28; Bishop of Gloucester, 1815-24; Bishop of Lichfield, 1824-36. Prominent Evangelical. Friend of William Wilberforce, Zachary Macaulay, Hannah More &c. Died 1836.

Mother

Sophia (daughter of Thomas March Phillipps of Garendon Park, Leicestershire and Susan Lisle). Born 1781, married 1802, died 1862.

Brothers

1. Henry, Canon of Lichfield. Born 1803, died 1877. Married 1st Cornelia Cornish (1828), 2nd Julia Tucker (1841).

Children (by Cornelia) Susan, Charles, Louisa, Henry.  
(by Julia) Harry, Edith, Mary Margaret, Alice (and 3 more who died as infants).

2. Charles, R.N. Born 1806, drowned 1825.

3. George, born 1810, married Sophia Sargent, died 1880. *clerk in Holy orders*

Children: Henry, George Lisle, <sup>Alice</sup> Caroline, Charles, Cyril, Cecilia, Beatrice.

4. Arthur, born 1811, died 1880.

5. William, Barrister at Law, H.M. Arbitrator in the Mixed Court at New York. Born 1813, died 1894.

6. Thomas, Barrister at Law, Registrar of the Diocese of Manchester. Born 1815, died 1886. *(usually called Tom)*

7. Edward, born 1818, died 1846. *(sometimes called The Ted)*

8. Alfred, Admiral of the Fleet, G.C.B. Born 1820, married 1852 Louisa Dawson (who died 1855) Died 1888.

Children: Edward, born 1853, died 1877.

9. Richard, Scholar and Fellow of Wadham College, Oxford, Barrister at Law. Born 1822, died 1897 *(Also known as Dick)*

Sisters

1. Anna, born 1805, married 1827 Rt. Hon. Sir George Grey Bart, died 1893. *(usually called Annie)*

Children: George, b. 1835, d. 1874.

2. Emily, born 1808, died 1885. *(Also known as Minnie)*

3. Sophia, Superior of the Convent of the Good Shepherd, Cardiff, born 1817, died 1901 *(usually called Sophy)*.

Uncles (Ryder)

1. Dudley, 1st Earl of Harroby. Born 1762, Lord President of the Council, died 1847.

Children: Dudley (Viscount Sandon, later 2nd Earl), Granville (succeeded to Westbrook), William, Frederick; Susan (m. Earl Fortescue), Mary (m. Admiral Edward Saurin), Georgiana (m. Lord Wharnccliffe), Harriet (m. Rev. Lord Charles Hervey), Louisa (m. Hon. George Fortescue).

2. Richard, of Westbrook Hay, Hertfordshire. Born 1766, d. 1832.

Children: Susan.

1. Charles, of Garendon Park, Leicestershire, born 1779 died 1862.

2. Samuel, born 1780, died 1862. Under Secretary of State.
